

(b) Foundational Literacy & Numeracy (FLN). For the benefit of the teachers who joined in recently, FLN & its characteristics of National Framework as per the guidelines of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, was also covered in the workshop. The aim of the policy is to "Create an enabling environment to ensure the universal acquisition of Fundamental Literacy and Numeracy, so that by 2026-27 every child achieves the desired learning competency in reading, writing and numeracy.
